## SCIENCE

## ;S.T.E.M Project

'Students are looking forward to being able to start their lighting design for their "tomb" (a.k.a. shoebox). This whole lighting unit is centered on the story we read to introduce the unit, which is set in Egypt and addresses the optical engineering involved in how light 'was reflected inside pharaohs' tombs. Students will be working with their peers to incorporate knowledge of light travel, reflection, intensity with creativity to design and build a system of mirrors (and other imisc. materials) to bend the beam of light (from the flashlight) to illuminate hieroglyphics on the tomb iwalls. The system will be evaluated based on light intensity \& total cost of their design (using faux money iof course).I hope to have time remaining for students to be able to present their designs to the class.
