#### MAP TIMFI

FOCUS QUESTION: How can we use geographic tools to describe a community's location?

#### Overview of Skills to be learned/practiced:

- i-Identifying different types of maps (population, resource, landform, political, etc) and understanding their purpose.
- -Locate & label the equator & each of the 7 continents
- -Use a compass rose to describe cardinal & intermediate directions
- Find the distance (in miles) between given points using a map scale
- -Find locations using a grid map (which will lead into understanding latitude & longitude)
